To whom these presents shall come greeting Shew ye that by virtue of a Land Office
Treasury Warrant Number eighteen thousand six hundred and sixty seven issued the
fourteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and eighty three, there is
granted by the said Commonwealth unto Thomas Jarr a certain Tract or piece
of land containing one hundred and sixty four Acres by Survey bearing date the
fourteenth day of August one thousand one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
lying and being in the County of Randolph adjoining Lands of Michael
Jarr whereon he now lives on the East side and bounded as followeth to wit,
Beginning at a Birch and Maple an old corner of said Jarrs and running
thence South fifty one degrees East forty two poles to a white oak South fifteen degrees
West eight poles to a corner of John Bohensiths thence along his line, South
fifty eight degrees East thirty poles to a white oak corner of said Bohensith thence
along his line South fifty four degrees East one hundred poles to a white oak a corner of said
Bohensith thence North forty two degrees East sixty poles to a hickory and poplar North twenty
eight poles to a white oak North twenty degrees West ten poles to a white oak North
fifty five degrees East sixty poles to a white oak and Sower Gum North twelve degrees
West forty poles to a white oak North forty one degrees West fifty six poles to a white
oak and Maple South thirty four degrees West fifty two poles to a white oak, South fifty two
degrees West one hundred and ninety poles to the Beginning with its Appurtenances to have and
to hold the said tract or parcel of land with its Appurtenances to the said Thomas
